Hello Waldorf Families and Friends,

We've been working to get our newsletter back up and running, and I think we're getting there. Although I have met many of you, I thought I would take this opportunity to introduce myself.

I come to Anchorage Waldorf School after five years with Sparc: a creative place. Sparc is an art gallery and studio, and provides classes to artists of all abilities.
