

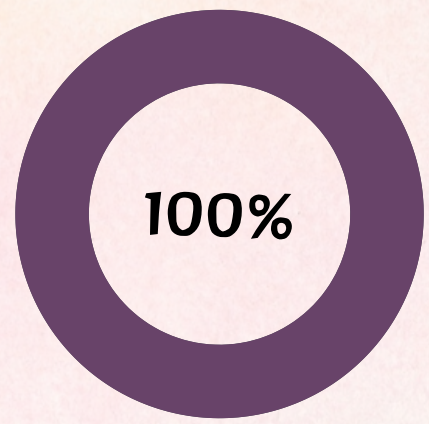
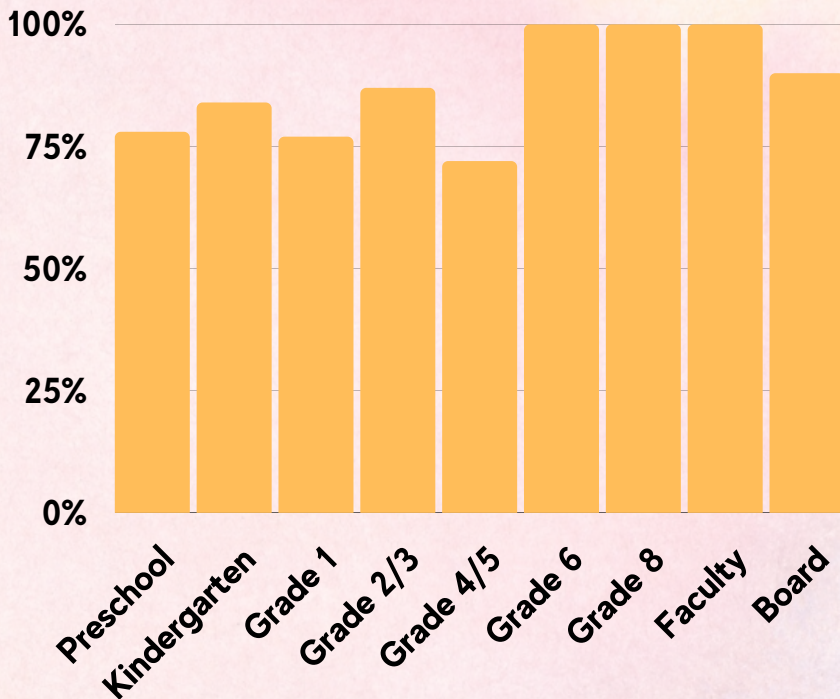

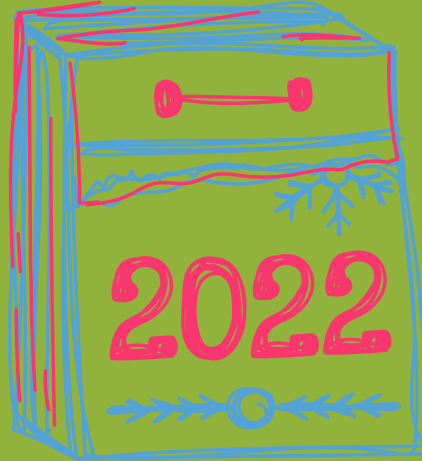


Lost & Found Clothing

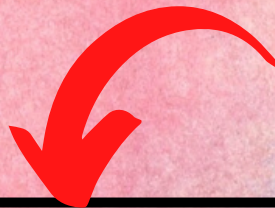
1. Remember to label your child's gear.
