Anchorage Waldorf School Martinmas Lantern Walk Thursday, November 10th 6:00 pm



As the outer darkness closes in and the sun's warmth weakens, many Waldorf schools celebrate the old European custom of walking with homemade paper lanterns on St. Martin's Eve. The younger children have been making all kinds of lanterns to prepare for the festival of light, while the older children will create a beautiful lit archway for us all to walk under. This night's spiritual aspect is preparing ourselves for the darkening winter months by making a home for our light to live. So that Father Sun's rays have a place to dwell in the darkness of winter. It is the light of inspiration, wisdom, and love which culminates in mid-winter's hope.

Younger children should pick up their lanterns in their classrooms, then gather at the bonfire by 6:00 pm to light lanterns and sing through our lantern songs. The group will then form a procession following Ms. Ashley and Ms. Michele, singing as we walk together in the community along our twinkling path. Then share a quiet cup of apple cider and a small star cookie before walking back to your car and home for a quiet dinner (by candlelight, perhaps) and bed.

- Adults, please bring a lantern from home.
- Please, park along the streets close to school, then walk quietly to AWS.
  - Respect the mood of reverence and wonder through quiet speech.


#### Dear Community,
